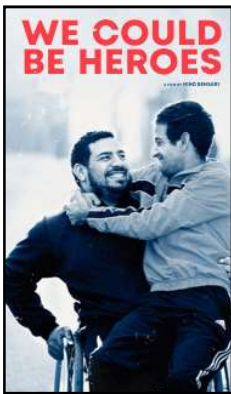

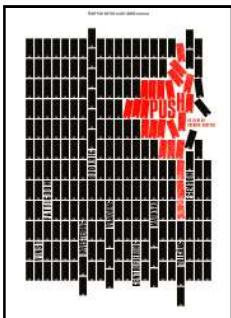


**We Could Be Heroes**
