

Sfi - Swedish for immigrants

SFI courses are designed for immigrants to give them basic knowledge of the Swedish language. You will learn to speak, read and write in Swedish. You will also practice conversation, in everyday and workplace scenarios. You will receive a grade after completing the course. There is no charge for participating in an SFI course.

SFI (Swedish for Immigrants) living in Lund municipality
– for Swedish residents lacking basic skills and proficiency in Swedish.

Eligibility to participate in SFI

You must have a Swedish personal identity number (in Swedish, personnummer) to participate in SFI. Alternatively, you will be eligible if you have a coordination number (in Swedish, samordningsnummer). You must also be at least 16 years old.

You are welcome to visit LundaVälkomsten during our opening hours. Here you will meet our receptionist who will register your visit, thereafter you will receive information and assistance in applying to a SFI course. You will be asked questions in regards to your background, previous work experience and studies for us to be able to make an individual assessment in which path within SFI is best suitable.

Do you already have some previous knowledge in Swedish you will also be able to discuss with a teacher and possibly do a language test to find out at what level of SFI course you should attend.
