... enough free space that's accessible and suitable for play and outdoor activities ...

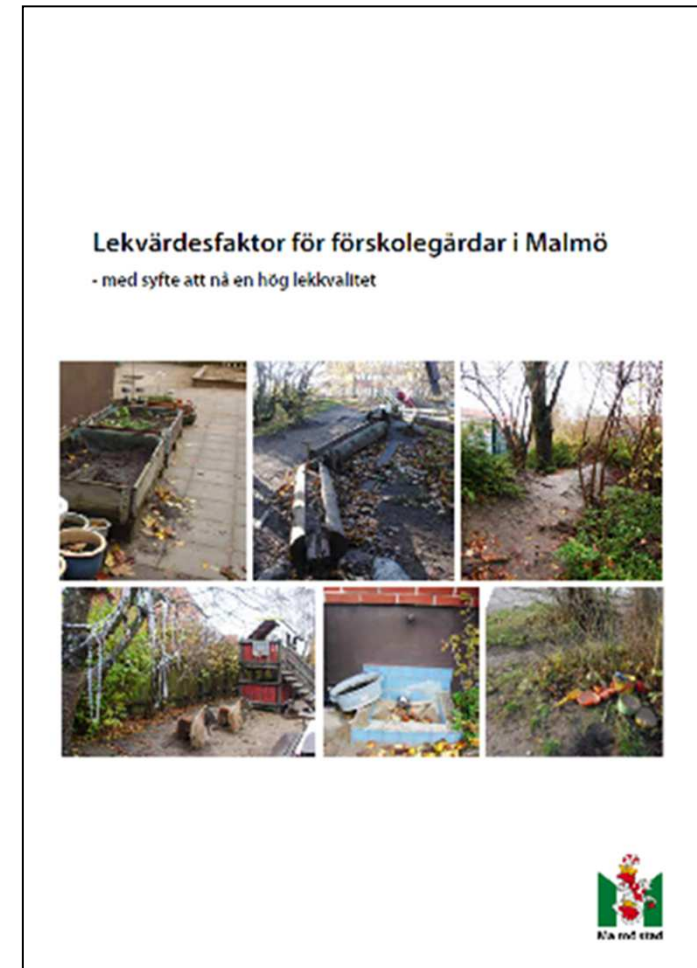
- New general recommendation 1 March 2015 (Boverket)
